Dear Parents / Caregivers,

This coming Friday and Saturday a group of our students will be performing in the School Spectacular at the Sydney Entertainment Centre. I wish them great success in what I am sure will be an amazing show. Thanks to Mrs Riley and Miss Allam for the time you have put into preparing and supporting the students in order to get ready for this event.

Curriculum Differentiation Project

Our teachers are currently participating in a state-wide project on Curriculum Differentiation (in other words, tailoring teaching very tightly to match where students are now, and where they need to go next). Over 90 schools applied to be a part of this project, and only 11 were selected. Over the past two years, this has been a very strong focus of our Professional Learning program for staff, and has resulted in some very positive changes to the ways that we assess, the way that we structure groupings of students for teaching & learning in English and Mathematics, and the way we plan and program learning experiences for students.



Today our Stage 2 teaching team will be meeting to move into the next phase of this project, looking at curriculum differentiation in Writing. The Stage Three team will undertake similar professional learning on Thursday.

New Syllabuses are coming

Next year will see the introduction of a new Board of Studies English syllabus in all NSW schools. Our teachers have worked very hard this year during the School Development Days, at staff meetings and in their stages to familiarise themselves with the new syllabus and to prepare for the associated changes. One of the big changes is in the types of texts that students will be expected to study. There is an increasing emphasis on children developing skills with texts that go beyond the traditional 'print' style. We know that children operate in an increasingly complex world, gaining information from multiple sources (traditional print / online) and frequently create content of their own. The new English syllabus recognises this and encourages the development of children's skills in understanding, interpreting and manipulating these 'multi-modal' types of texts.
