This can be quite a daunting process for the teachers involved – particularly when the participants are required to 'teach behind the screen' – in other words, run a Reading Recovery lesson in a specialised room with a one way glass window, on the other side of which are all of their colleagues watching on and offering suggestions and feedback. Well done and congratulations Mrs Bruno on your graduation. We are very proud of you.

On Friday we had lots of little Pirates and Princesses in Kindergarten. They all looked fantastic and had a wonderful time parading in their costumes, with many exciting activities occurring through the day.
